

From Research Data Management to Data Platforms: A Hugging Face Approach

Does research data management as we know it in the context of database research or data science need platforms like Hugging Face? Or are platforms and services such as Kaggle or GESIS sufficient? In this talk, after giving a brief overview of the core features of Hugging Face, we claim that the data research community would benefit a lot from a platform similar to Hugging Face, in particular when considering the support of the FAIR principles. We will also stress that proper infrastructures for research data management should go beyond just managing datasets and making them accessible to the research community. In particular, in view of large-scale data management, processing and analysis, it would be extremely helpful to provide researchers a platform that offers various tools and APIs to easily interact with and explore diverse forms of data.
